REPORT

One day NAAC sponsored seminar on “New NAAC Accreditation System For Aided And Self-Financing Colleges In Rural Area: Challenges And Opportunities” was organized by Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Mahatma Gandhi Arts, Science and Late Nasaruddinbhai Panjwani Commerce College, Armori (Re-accredited by NAAC with ‘A’ Grade) on February 23rd, 2019. The main aim of organizing seminar was to understand, learn the new methodology adopted by NAAC and to acquaint various stakeholders working in higher education institutions where they actually stand and which qualitative needs are demanded from them by NAAC.

(Session –I)

Inaugural Session

The seminar was inaugurated at the hands of Hon’ble Vice- Chancellor of Gondwana University, Gadchiroli Dr. Namdeo Kalyankar. He chaired the inaugural session. The guests of honour were Dr. Ganesh Hegde, Deputy Advise, NAAC Bangalore, Dr. Shirish Chindhade, formerly principal, MU College of Commerce, Pimpri-Pune and NAAC Assessor. Convener Principal Dr. Lalsingh Khalsa and IQAC co-ordinator Prof. Nomes Meshram sat on dias.

The inaugural programme began with lamp lighting and garlanding the images of Gandhiji, Tukdoji Maharaj, Late Wamanraoji Wanmali, Late Abdulbhai Panjwani and followed by welcome song and Gondwana University song. After the floral welcome of the dignitaries, Principal Dr. Lalsingh Khalsa introduced the theme of the seminar and objectives behind organizing the seminar. The seminar proceeding was released at the hands of the dignitaries in inaugural session. Chairperson of the inaugural session Dr. Namdeo Kalyankar, V.C., Gondwana University, Gadchiroli spoke about the importance of NAAC accreditation for higher education institutions. He also touched on major problems and difficulties faced by the rural colleges in education process.

There were two technical sessions in the seminar and in all four sessions including inaugural session and valedictory session.

The seminar witnessed 86 participants (50 Registered and 36 non-registered) from 38 aided and self financing colleges of nearby area.



Keynote Address: Dr. Ganesh Hegde

The keynote address was given by Dr. Ganesh Hegde, Deputy Adviser, NAAC Bangalore. In the beginning he emphasized on the importance of NAAC Through his power point presentation he gave information on various levels of quality indicators of NAAC and laid emphasis on the important role of all stakeholders in building the quality in higher education. He explained the need for accreditation and concerns relating better quality standards and global trends in higher education. The benefits of assessment and accreditation were explained by him. He touched upon the changes introduced in the revised accreditation framework. The process of data validation and verification and the metrics introduced for the same were discussed by Dr. Ganesh Hegede in detail. He introduced the participants about key indicators of seven criteria, procedure of IIQA, SSR writing etc. The required framework of NAAC intends to enhance the redeeming features of accreditation process and make it more transparent. Proper importance has been given to all stakeholders. However students' participation in teaching learning process and evaluation is considered of great concern. Dr. Hegde said that students' satisfaction is a direct indicator of the effectiveness of teaching learning process in the institution. Students' satisfaction survey is a robust and transparent process to know about actual teaching learning process in the institution. Thus NAAC has tried to inspire faculty to upgrade themselves with new interactive and participatory teaching learning methods. He motivated the participants by saying that by involving the students in every activity of the institutions and imparting the best of knowledge to them with the help of latest ICT tools, we can inspire them to respond to the questionnaire enthusiastically sensibly and sensitively. Proper planning and systematic execution of strategies are key factors to go through SSS successfully. Regular meeting with students to create awareness among them and to let them know about various facilities and activities in the institution will help us go through the process. Dr. Hegde concluded that creative initiatives by teachers in teaching, student-friendly non-teaching staff and flexible management are sure to have positive reactions from students in SSS. Dr. Hegde guided participants about SSS in a very simple and placid manner. In short, the delegates found Dr. Hegde's keynote speech very informative and beneficial.

Technical Session I : Dr. Shirish Chindhade

Dr. Shirish Chindhade, the resource person of Technical Session 1 delivered his deliberations on "New NAAC Accreditation System" Dr. Raju Munghate, Principal, Govindrao Munghate College, Kurkheda chaired first technical session. He introduced delegates New



framework of NAAC accreditation and assessment. He gave his valuable information and guidance from assessor point of view. He talked particularly on the problems related to quality, quantity, accessibility and excellence. He said that recently in the new methodology the Peer Team visit is just a simple physical verification of the higher education institutes, but the main focus should be laid on the qualitative and quantitative metrics of the new methodology. He gave some highlights on SSS (Student Satisfaction Survey). He acquainted all the delegates with new guidelines of NAAC to bring efficiency and efficacy in the process of assessment and accreditation.

Dr. Raju Munghate, chairperson addressed the delegates and expected from them more comprehensive reading of NAAC guidelines.

Technical Session II : Dr. Shirish Chindhade

The second technical session was chaired by Dr. N. S. Kokode, Principal, N. H. College, Bramhapuri. Dr. Shirish Chindhade, resource person of this technical session began with the appreciation of IQAC of this college for organizing such seminar with the overwhelming response of the participants. He said that most of the colleges in rural area run in a single room and do not have proper infrastructure and faculty to conduct classes. The guardians as well as students studying the rural colleges are in constant worry of earning their livelihood. Due to severe financial conditions and the worry of earning money, these students remains absent in the classes. He warned that it will be a serious matter when the student satisfactory survey will be conducted by NAAC.

He spoke on "Challenges before Aided and Self financing College in Rural Area and measures to be undertaken" Through power point presentation Dr. Shirish Chindhade showed NAAC's expectations from colleges. He elaborated the background behind NAAC and put different questions to the delegates on the theme of seminar. He explained seven criteria which are considered as a basis for assessment with any key indicators under each criteria and their weightages.

Chairperson Dr. N. S. Kokode motivated the delegates to involve and participate actively in the process of quality enhancement.

Valedictory Session.

The valedictory session was chaired by Principal Dr. Lalsingh Khalsa. Chief guests were Principal Dr. N. S. Kokode, Principal Dr. Raju Munghate, Principal Dr. Sanjay Singh, Principal Dr. J. V. Dadve.



All the dignitaries sitting on the dias addressed the valedictory session. They appreciated the college for providing an opportunity to meet and listen eminent academicians like Dr. Ganesh Hegde and Dr. Shirish Chindhade. Chairperson Dr. Lalsingh Khalsa, Principal Mahatma Gandhi Arts, Science and Late Nasaruddinbhai Panjwani Commerce College, Armori concluded by saying that it was a moment of pride for our institution to organize such significant and highly relevant seminar.

Prof. Nomesh Meshram, IQAC co-ordinator proposed a formal vote of thanks and the seminar concluded with the distribution of certificates.

Outcome of the seminar:

In the light of new framework of NAAC methodology, it is essential for all colleges to go through manual guidelines and study carefully all assessment indicators, weightages and instructions. Accreditation has been made mandatory by UGC and linked it to the funding for the government run institutions. A college being accredited usually signifies that it has met certain standards of excellence in accessing its operations. In Quality enhancement of the institutions the IQAC play a very crucial role. IQAC must plan innovatively the various activities/projects to undertake and must implement them in their institutions. ICT based teaching learning should be adopted. There are many challenges glaring at the HEI's in rural area. These thwart the process of quality enhancement. The revised assessment paradigm shift posed serious challenges before HEI's in rural area.


The institutions can impart the teaching-learning –evaluation activity, curriculum, infrastructure, library, management, research, student support, best practices, institutional values in such a manner that it all should be fulfilling the quality parameters and catering to the needs of the students.

The institutions situated in the rural background are somehow getting well equipped with ICT these days, but it shall consume some time to enable technologically to ensure effective institutional functioning.

Strengths and weaknesses are part and parcel of every HEI, but rural institutions have more weaknesses in compare to the urban institutions. Backwardness lack of ambition, deficiency of opportunity, barriers/ inadequacy to make use of ICT are some of the hurdles in the rural Institutions. These hurdles need to be overcome for successfully facing NAAC and contributing to the overall development of our rural students.

The old well established institutions, entitled the status of 12B are funded by UGC for conducting seminars/workshops/conferences etc. Organization of such academic events require good infrastructure experienced faculty, staff, enough accommodation and transport connectivity to attract the delegates. The colleges in rural, remote are either find unfit for the organization of such events or the event is sure to be unsuccessful.

In short, all agreed with the conclusion that if we are able to enhance the quality of rural educational institutions, naturally the status of higher education will be raised. India would be a developed country until and unless the higher education quality reaches to satisfactory heights in rural areas.


