The details are as follows:-

ACTIVITY (1): Tree Plantation Drive. (July 2020 - October 2020).

Name of Activity: "Each one student plant one tree" and plantation on barren land. Tree plantation in adopted villages and 905 saplings planted in and around the village forest, uncultivated and barren land.

Area of Plantation: Palora- Antarjee Road, Open barren land, adopted Village Antarjee, Kasavi and Palora, College campus, Near Old ITI Armori. Near Tasar regional centre and remaining sampling planted at students residing villages. Programme was conducted under the guidance of Principal Dr. L.H.Khalsa.

Activity was organised with the cooperation of NSS department. Dr. G. M. kadhao, Prof. Seema Nagdeve, Prof. Satendra Sontakke, Dr. C. P. Dorlikar, Dr. R. M. Thombre, Prof. M. K. Ramteke, Prof. Parag Meshram, Dr. Vijay Gorde, Dr. C. D. Mungmode, Dr. Manoj Thaware, Prof. D. M. Ghonmode, Dr. R. V. Ghonmode and Prof. Sunil Chute were cooperated this activity in great success.

Need of the Activity: Inhabitants of the adopted village are much unknown about the tree. Even though their life is totally depends upon agriculture. For the good yields rain water is essential components. Hence we arranged tree plantation drive in villages and nearby areas. We conduct general meetings with the Sarpanch Shri. Watgureji with following purpose to complete our target to achieved 905 saplings plantation and conservation by involving the local inhabitants. Importance of tree plantation has been stressed upon time and again. The need for tree plantation has become even greater these days because of the growing pollution in the environment. Tree plantation involves transplanting tree seedlings to grow forests and spread greenery around. There are a number of reasons why the process of tree plantation is important for the environment. Tree plantation is good for the environment. Everyone knows that trees are the source of oxygen. They inhale carbon dioxide and exhale oxygen without which the survival of living beings is not possible on earth.

Apart from inhaling carbon dioxide trees also absorb various harmful gases including sulfur dioxide and carbon monoxide and also filter harmful pollutants from the atmosphere

The growing amount of air pollution caused by the smoke emitted by vehicles and factories can be controlled only if we plant more and more trees. Importance of Tree Plantation for Forestry

- Even though trees offer so many benefits and are extremely important for maintaining the ecological balance, we are cutting these ruthlessly. Tree plantation is essential to compensate for this loss.
- Trees Exhale the Life Giving Oxygen: A famous quote reads, "Imagine if trees gave off Wifi signals we'd be planting so many trees, we'd probably save the planet. Too bad they only produce oxygen we breathe". It is sad how we have grown so accustomed to technology that we overlook the harmful impact it is having on our environment. Not only is the use of technology destroying nature but it is also separating us from the same.

More and more trees must be planted if we really want to survive and lead a good life. Besides exhaling oxygen and inhaling carbon dioxide, trees also absorb other harmful gases from the environment thus making the air purer and fresher. The greener the tree the more oxygen it shall produce and the more toxic gases it will absorb.

The pollution level these days is rising high. The only way to fight it is by growing more and more trees. The areas that are surrounded by trees, for instance, villages and forests boast of a cleaner environment. This is because these are less impacted by the pollution. rest are so engrossed in their lives that they do not understand that without enough trees around we wouldn't be able to live long. It is time we must recognize the importance of tree plantation and contribute our bit towards the same.





ACTIVITY 2: Swachhata Hi Sewa And Plastic Free Village Campaign Name of Activity: PLASTIC AWARENESS OR SAY NO TO PLASTIC.

Need of the Activity: We know very well that, today villagers are unknowing uses plastic carries bags, bottles and plastic domestic use cups & glass etc. They are unknown about its effects on living being hence such activities are needful for the betterment of the society and other life servive. Some of the students did the dusting of the rooms. And others went to the play ground and started picking wrappers lying scattered there. After collecting them they threw them in to the dustbins. 




