PLANT MORPHOLOGY



Botanical Name : - *Baliospermum montanum* (Willd.) Muell-Arg.

Family : - Euphorbiaceae

Local Name : - Jamal-gota

Morphology : -

Monoecious under-shrubs; branches greenish, arising from the base; young parts pubescent. Leaves variable, all leaves glabrous above, pubescent beneath; lower broadly ovate in outline, 3–5-lobed, base rounded or cuneate and 2-glandular, sinuate-toothed; upper ones small, lanceolate; stipules reduced to 2 glands. Flowers in axillary racemes, with numerous males and a few females at base. Male calyx globose, 4–5-partite, concave; stamens 15–20. Female calyx obovate; ovary globose, hairy; styles 2-partite, dull red. Seeds ellipsoid, mottled.

Flowering & Fruiting: **October to February.**

Uses : -

Roots decoction used for stomach pain due to indigestion or constipation, Scanty urination, dropsy, skin diseases.
