PLANT MORPHOLOGY



Botanical Name : - Plumbago zeylanica L.

Family : - Plumbaginaceae

Local Name : - Chitarak

Morphology :-

Erect subshrubs; stem striate. Leaves ovate or elliptic-ovate, base shortly and abruptly attenuated into a short petiole, apex acute or subacute, somewhat glaucous beneath, amplexicaul at base and often auriculate. Flowers white, in elongate, terminal, often panicled recemes; rachis with sessile glands; bracteoles ovate, acuminate. Calyx narrowly tubular, densely covered with stalked glands; lobes small. Stamens 5. Ovary ellipsoid, 1-locular; stigma 5-fid. Capsules oblong, enclosed in calyx. Seed solitary, ellipsoid.

Flowering & Fruiting: - July to October.

Uses : - Root used for treatment of various diseases related to digestive system like weak digestion, piles, abdominal pain, skin diseases.
