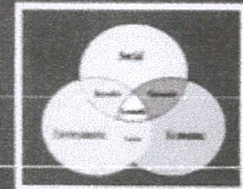

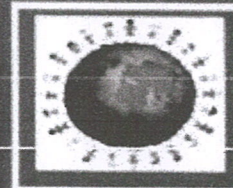

A Geographical View on Sex Ratio in Vidarbha Region -2011

Abstract:

Sex ratio is a term used to define number of females per 1000 male. It's a source to find the equality of male and female in society at a given period of time. Studies from 2001 to 2011 show that the sex ratio of Vidarbha is appropriate as compared to the whole of Maharashtra, also the general sex ratio and child sex ratio of Naxal-affected and backward districts are appropriate as compared to the developed districts of Maharashtra.

Key words: - Population, Sex Ratio, Vidarbha

Introduction:

Sex ratio is the ratio of male to female in a population. Female sex ratio commonly known as sex ratio is the number of females per every 1000 males in a given place. According to census of India in 2011; 1.21 billion people living in India. Total male population in India is 623.7 million and total female population in India is 586.5 million. The total female sex ratio in India is 940: 1000 males and the female child sex ratio is 944 girls' children per every 1000 boys' children of the same age group the overall female sex ratio has increased by 0.75% in the census 2011 as compared to the previous census 2001.

Vidarbha is the eastern region of Maharashtra state. Vidarbha comprises the division Amravati and Nagpur which include 11 districts of Amravati, Akola, Buldhana, Washim, Yavatmal, to Nagpur, Wardha, Bhandara, Gondia, Gadchiroli, and Chandrapur. All districts in Vidarbha have a sex ratio higher than the state average sex ratio of 925. The sex ratio in most other districts of the state have reported a drop but out of 11 districts in 7 districts in Vidarbha have recorded a rise in their sex ratio figures. The Naxalite Gadchiroli district has the highest sex ratio in the state with 956 girls on every 1,000 boys and the second highest is reported from the farmers suicide-stricken district of Chandrapur 945.

Area of study:

Vidarbha region is located in the Central of India and East side of Maharashtra. Vidarbha occupying 45868 square kilometers area between 19°05' to 21° 47' North latitude and 72° 09' to 79° 11' East latitude. Area covered of Vidarbha is 97321 square kilometers and it covers 31.64 7% percentage area of Maharashtra.

Vidarbha region shares its boundary with state of Chhattisgarh towards the east, Madhya Pradesh in the north, Telangana in south and Aurangabad and Nashik administrative division of Maharashtra state in the west. Vidarbha has been divided in Amravati and Nagpur administrative division of Maharashtra. Amravati administrative division in the west side of Vidarbha region with five district Buldhana, Akola, Washim, Yavatmal besides Amravati district. Nagpur administrative division is in the East side of Vidarbha with 6 district Wardha, Bhandara, Gondia, Chandrapur, Gadchiroli besides Nagpur district, in all Vidarbha represent 11 districts.

Objective and Important of Study:

Across Maharashtra, the sex ratio has changed in 2011 as compared to 2001, which has seen a change in the sex ratio in Vidarbha as well as a significant decrease in the child sex ratio, but it is important to study the increase in the sex ratio in Gadchiroli district.
