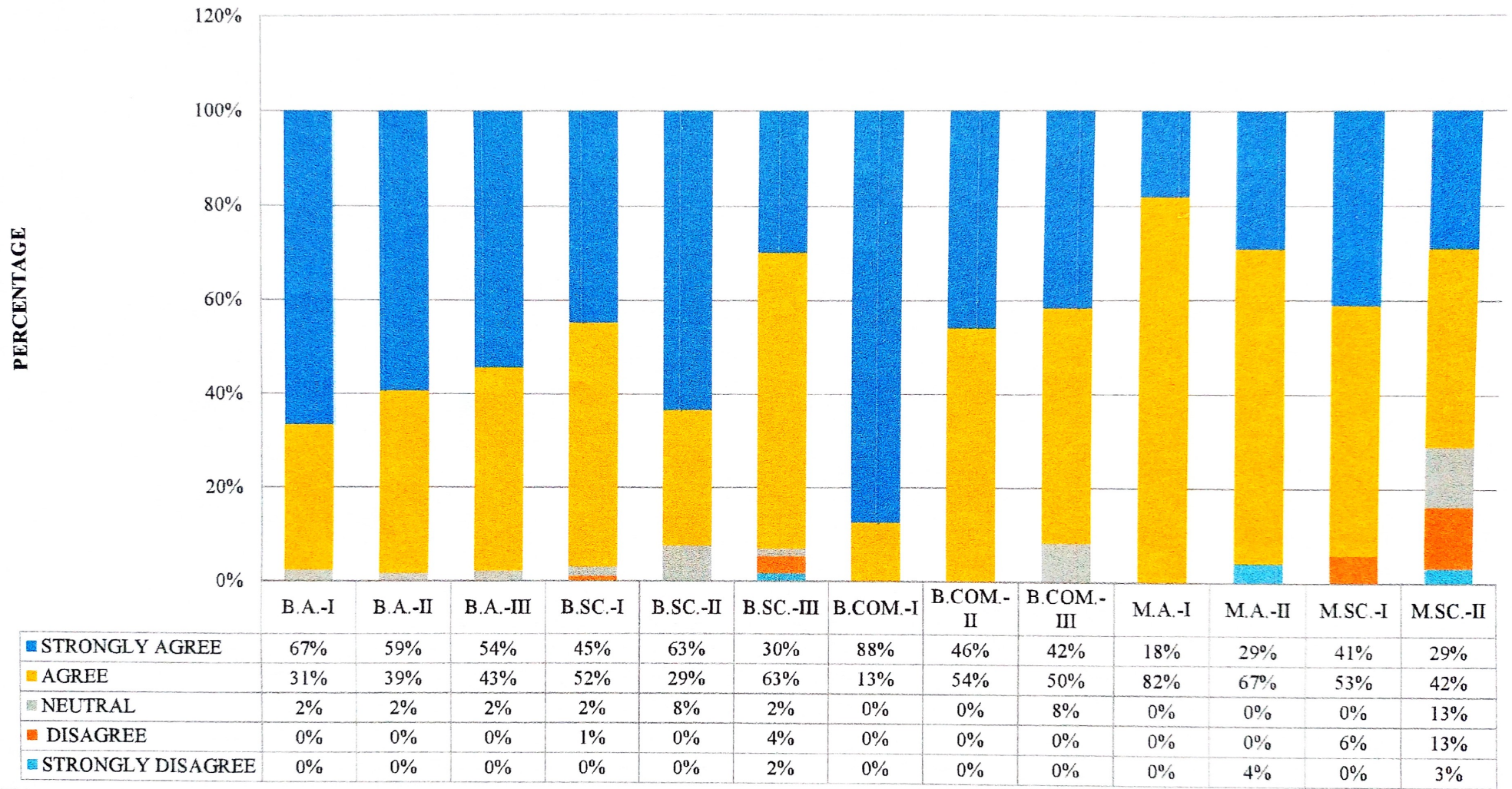







### Q.No.-13. Suggestions (If any)


## Students Feedback Analysis
