At the global level, human activities have caused and will continue to cause a loss in biodiversity. Change in climate exert additional pressure and have already begun to affect biodiversity. The general effect of projected human-induced climate change is that the habitats of many species will move pole ward or upward from their current locations. Globally by the year 2080 about 40% of biodiversity could be lost. The risk of extinction will increase for many species that are already vulnerable. Changes in biodiversity at ecosystem and landscape scale, in response to climate change and other pressure would further affect global and regional climate. Changes in biodiversity in response to climate change is present significant challenges

We need healthy and productive ecosystems to benefit from the multiple environmental, economic and social benefits they provide. Ecosystem restoration offers the opportunity to effectively halt and reverse degradation, improve ecosystem services and recover biodiversity. There are many different facets of restoration ecology, and they include practices such as erosic reforestation and revegetation (or replanting the native species of plants), removal of non-native species and reintroduction of native animal species.

Education empowerment equips women with knowledge, skills and critical thinking abilities, enabling them to challenge stereotypes, pursue their aspirations and contribute to their personal and social development. Dr. Vikhar Sir has expressed this opinion in his conclave speech.
