PLANT MORPHOLOGY



Botanical Name : - *Asparagus racemosus* Wild.

Family : - Liliaceae

Local Name : - Shatavari

Morphology : -

Under-shrubs, scandent, spinous, much branched; rootstock tuberous, roots many. Leaves linear, subulate with stout conical spinous spurs, straight, pointed, needle like. Inflorescence raceme. Flowers white, perianth 2–3 mm long. Stamens 6. Ovary superior, style short, stigma 3. Fruit berries globose, 1 seeded, red, when mature.

Flowering & Fruiting: - July to November.

Uses : -

It is also used for fluid retention, pain, diarrhoea, bronchitis, tuberculosis, dementia, and diabetes.
